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> 2 Hours Walking Tour: Jewish Sites in Berlins former Jewish Quarter <

This walking tour will take you through two old Berlin districts well known as the Barn District and the Spandau Suburbia.

(This tour may be of course also carried out with a vehicle)

...Make your way to the Jewish Quarter of Berlin where the rebuilt golden dome of the New Synagogue (1866) shines brightly today. This area has become one of the new vibrant hotspots of the city.

Walk through Grosse Hamburger Strasse and see the memorials dedicated to the former Jewish cemetery plundered and destroyed by the Nazis (with the memorial tombstone to Moses Mendelsohn) as well as a figurine group commemorating the deportations out of the Jewish senior citizen home that once stood here.

Next to this site you'll also see the first Jewish Boys School of Berlin. See where brave Non-Jewish Women were fighting for their Jewish husbands not to be taken to Concentration Camps.

Visit the place, nowadays a small museum, where a resolute opponent to the Nazi Regime, Otto Weidt, could hide and hence save many Jewish fellow citizens from being deported.

Additional places to be visited by vehicle or urban transports only

(Inside visit of Information Centre would extend the tour for about 45 minutes admission: € 6.00/person)
- **Jewish Museum by Daniel Libeskind**
(Inside visit would extend the tour for at least 1 hour, admission: € 6.00/person)
- **Track 17 - Memorial to the deported and expelled Jewish Citizens**
- **Jewish Community Centre of West-Berlin**
(Inside visit would extend the tour for about ½ hour)
- **Rykestrasse Synagogue**
(Inside visit only possible during services, besides these only on request and if available)
- **Quarter of "Bayerisches Viertel" – Art exhibition to the social marginalization of Jewish Citizens**
- **Exhibition "Topography of Terror" former area of the central offices of the Nazi regime**
(Inside visit would extend the tour for about one hour, admission free)
- **The Wannsee Conference Memorial**
(Inside visit would extend the tour for about one hour, admission free)

Depending on duration and place of departure, the route may vary.

Please be aware that due to traffic conditions and streets closed due to reasons beyond our control, some places of interest may not be available.

We will try to replace them with an alternative.

Naturally your tour can be adapted and extended to suit your personal interests.
